Scholarships and Scholarship Auction

Updated: March 16, 2010

The first NE Region Scholarship Auction occurred at the FY92 Region Conference hosted by the Maine Chapter on Oct. 11 – 13, 1991 at the Marriot Sable Oaks Hotel in South Portland, ME. The auction was started as a “Crafts Show” as a part of the Spouses Program under the leadership of Charlene Lemieux, Margaret Pelletier and Judy Mitsui. This small group wrote to all of the spouses and asked each to bring a small hand-made craft that would be auctioned with the proceeds being used to create a scholarship fund. This first auction of small hand-made crafts raised a little over \$400.00 and the seeds were planted.

As best that can be determined, the seeds that were planted in October 1991 did not sprout for several years. In September 1998, the Rochester Chapter hosted the Region Conference at the Hyatt Regency in Rochester and the Scholarship Auction was reintroduced as a part of the Cocktail Hour preceding the Awards Banquet. This time, the items to be auctioned went well beyond small hand-made crafts and as a result the auction raised over \$3000.00 which was distributed through a drawing held during the banquet.

Since 1998, the auction has become a little more formal with eligibility criteria spelled out in Region Policy. Only those attending the Region Conference or donating article for the auction are eligible to submit names to be considered for a scholarship. Eligible scholarship recipients are limited to current members of a Chapter within the Region or their spouse, child, niece, nephew, grandchild, step-relative, in-law or sibling and the recipient must be accepted at or enrolled in an institution of higher education. Scholarships are in the amount of \$1000 and a minimum of 3 are presented at each Region Conference.
